

## Home and School Meeting Minutes

January 16, 2012

The January 16, 2012, meeting was called to order by Stacey Lang at 7:00 pm.

Opening prayer was led by Mrs. Simon.

Christy Schwartz asked if there were any corrections to the November minutes. There were none, and the minutes were approved.

Stacey Lang gave the treasurer's report in Michelle's absence. The deposits were Chili Supper donations of \$9,580.00, Vendor Fair sales of \$961.00, Schwan's sales of \$225.33 and T-shirt and water bottle income of \$247.00. The major expense was school appreciation of \$2,303.60 which included the new AR program. The ending checking account balance is \$5,844.79, and the ending savings account balance is \$18,083.06.

Old Business – Stacey reported the Vendor Fair raised approximately \$1,186.00. The plan is to have another one in the fall with the hopes of having even more vendors participate.

Stacey Lang spoke about HFE Bucks next. Profits for the year are approximately \$4,400.00. She reminded everyone to keep using them. Tonya Rohr has inventory at home; feel free to call her on weekends or evenings.

New Business – Deana Rupp said the Chili Supper will be January 29<sup>th</sup>. Raffle sales have been going well. Extra sheets are available in the office. Two additional donations were recently received. One was an autographed KC Chiefs football and the other was a basket from Impressions Everlasting. Tickets can be purchased prior to the event or at the door. The committee is requesting each family donate two desserts. If you are bringing a dessert for the cake walk, please mark it. A reminder was given that no nuts on any dessert can be served. The Auditorium will not be ready to be used for the Chili Supper. The activity center will remain as it was last year. The games will be in the lower level classrooms. The cake walk and prizes will be in the art room. Pam Mayers is still working on volunteers. There are a few spots that need to be filled. They are in the kitchen, Bingo, and game room. Let Pam know if you are interested. Trina Gottschalk and Dana Schumacher will be the Chili Supper co-chairs next year as Deana and Pam will be stepping down. Fifth graders will be helping in the dining room while the 6<sup>th</sup> graders will be working in the game rooms and selling water with the Dominic Savio Club.

Deana said the next McDonald's Neighbors Night will be either April 12<sup>th</sup> or 19<sup>th</sup> at the North McDonalds.

Stacey is working on a Pizza Hut fundraiser for February.

Stacey reported that replacements will be needed for the Home and School Officers next year including the President, Treasurer, and Secretary.

Mrs. Simon then gave the Principal's report. She said the teachers are beginning to schedule practice times for state testing. Preschool letters will be going out soon. Whether a student is allowed to attend preschool will be determined by the priests. If the family is active in their parish and tithes, there should not be any issues. The two sessions for next year are full with good families. The new music room has been completed. It is very open and bright; Mr. Sauer and the children are really enjoying it.

The drawing for the Chili Supper raffle tickets was held. Sandee Werth won the adult sheet, and Rachel Staab won the child sheet.

Mike and Michelle Schlyer reported on the Auditorium. They have had successful volunteer work nights. The sacristy will be a storage space for HFE. There will not be a stage, but risers will be used for performances. The court will be regulation width, but is four to five feet short on length. Varsity games will not be able to be held there. Jeff Vahling will start on the floor in approximately six weeks. Volunteers will be requested for painting. The project should be completed by April for all the end of the year performances. A tour on the Auditorium was given.
